

## 7 DAYS/6 NIGHTS IN HONG KONG

### Day 1 ARRIVE HONG KONG

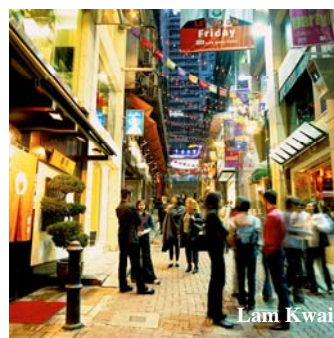
Arrive and check in at hotel. Then enjoy a sunset cruise with seafood dinner at **Lei Yue Mun**, an off-the-beaten track destination adored by seafood aficionados. After dinner, now is your chance to meet with the locals and prove your bargaining skills in the amazing **Temple Street Night Market**.



### Day 2 HONG KONG

A morning Hong Kong Island tour provides you a very good orientation about Hong Kong and will circle the beautiful Island with stops at **Stanley Market** where you can stroll through this seaside village bazaar. **Aberdeen Fishing Village**, home of “Boat People” whose life style has not changed much since the early days. (Optional sampan ride available at own expenses.) En route you will be able to view the most popular beach in town the **Repulse Bay Beach**. Visit an exquisite jewellery factory where the world’s famous jewelry-setting art carries out. Finish your tour with a panoramic bus ride brings you up to the **Victoria Peak** where the harbour and the city sprawl in front of you.

In the evening, choose either the **SoHo** area of Central district or Knutsford Terrace in Tsim Sha Tsui for dinner. Both are packed with door-to-door restaurants offering a host of international cuisine - from Chinese and Italian to Mexican and Japanese. Here you can savour dishes from the Himalayas to the Louisiana bayou, from Malaysia to the Mediterranean.



### Day 3 HONG KONG

Explore Hong Kong's largest outlying island just an hour's ferry ride away. The morning begins with a ferry trip from Central. Cruise through **Victoria Harbour** and pass islands dotted throughout the South China Sea to **Lantau Island's Silvermine Bay (Mui Wo)**. Visit the Tanka boat people's stilt-house fishing village at **Tai O**, then ride up to a 520-metre plateau to visit the famous **Po Lin Monastery** and view the world's largest seated outdoor bronze Buddha. The tour includes a vegetarian lunch prepared by the monks at the monastery.



**Day 4 HONG KONG**

**Disneyland** offers a fun-filled day for every family. Immerse yourselves in the storybook world of Fantasyland, embark on daring exploits in Adventureland, explore fascinating futurescapes in Tomorrowland or travel back in time to small town America in Main Street USA. The theme park also has a wide range of food outlets and specialty stores selling Disney memorabilia and souvenirs.

**Day 5 HONG KONG - MACAU - HONG KONG**

**Macau**, a Portuguese colony until Dec 1999, lies some 60 kilometers west of Hong Kong across the Pearl River estuary, is the oldest European settlement in the Far East dating back to 1557. More than 400 years of intermingling between Chinese and European cultures has given rise to a Macanese culture uniquely of its own. The tour will bring to you the historical sights of the **Ruins of the St. Paul Church**, the **Museum of Macau** (close on Monday,) the **Temple of A-MA**; a 400 years old temple in homage to a girl who saved seamen's life. Visit the gambling table of the world famous casino in Macau before return to Hong Kong. Lunch include at a local restaurant.



**Day 6 HONG KONG**

Depart for Shenzhen by catamaran. After customs and immigrations formalities, transfer to **Shekou of Shenzhen** to visit a kindergarten where you will be overwhelmed by the joy of the children. (Visit the **Legend of Nuwa** while Kindergarten in not opened on Saturday, Sunday and school holiday) visit a **Free Market**; and

the **Mineral Museum**. Then transfer to Guangzhou by coach through the express highway. Upon arrival to Guangzhou, lunch at local restaurant followed by city sightseeing including the **Chen Clan Academy, Dr. Sun Yat-Sen's Memorial Hall & Temple of Six Banyan Trees** and the **Western Han Tomb of the Nanyue King**. The tomb master was wearing a garment made of jade pieces, which was the earliest one discovered in China so far. Return to Hong Kong by comfortable express train. (Train rides approx. 2 hours)



**Day 7 DEPART HONG KONG**

Transfer to airport for depart flight back home.
