

## 7 DAYS/ 6 NIGHTS IN INDIA

### DAY 01 ARRIVE DELHI

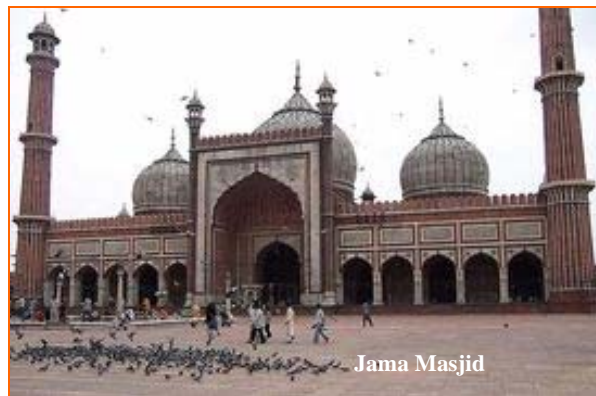
Meeting and assistance on arrival and transfer to hotel.

Overnight at hotel.

### DAY 02 DELHI

After breakfast sightseeing tour visiting Old Delhi and New Delhi. See **Jama Masjid** – the largest mosque in India, Spend some time in **Chandini Chowk** to savour the ambience of a crowded oriental bazaar. Drive past Red Fort - a marvel in red sandstone, visit **Raj Ghat** – memorial to **Mahatma Gandhi**. Later continue to visit New Delhi and visit the 12th century 230 feet high **Qutab Minar**, **Lodhi Gardens**. In these well-maintained gardens are the domed tombs of Sayyid and Lodi rulers. This garden is known for its fountains, ponds, flowering trees, blossoming shrubs and artificial streams. In the middle of the garden is **Bara Gumbad** (Big Dome), a mosque built in 1494. The garden has **Sheesh Gumbad** (Glass Dome), **Mohammad Shah's Tomb** and **Sikander Lodi's tomb**. These tombs boast of excellent architecture, and this style was later used in the construction of Taj Mahal., India Gate (memorial to the Indian army soldiers who died in the World War I), drive past the **Rashtrapati Bhavan** (formerly the viceroy's residence) and the **Parliament House**.  
Afternoon free at leisure.

Overnight at hotel.



### DAY 03 DELHI- AGRA (204 Kms)

After breakfast at hotel proceed by Car/ Coach for **Agra**. Before reaching Agra stop at **Sikandra** to see **Tomb of Emperor Akbar**. On arrival check-in at hotel. Afternoon visit the world famous Taj Mahal built by Shah Jahan in 1560 in memory of his queen **Mumtaz Mahal** to enshrine her mortal remains. (Friday closed).  
Overnight at hotel.

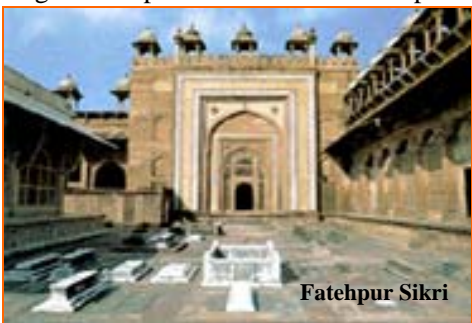
**DAY 04      AGRA**

After breakfast, visit Agra Fort containing the halls of private and public audiences and other palaces. Shah Jahan spent years of confinement at the hands of his son Aurangzeb, looking wistfully at the Taj Mahal from the **Fort. Itimad-ud-Daulah** is an exquisite tomb built by Nur Jahan for her father Mirza Ghiyas Beg. In many ways this tomb foreshadows the Taj Mahal and was the first construction in India which the marble inlay work was so beautifully and extensively used. Also enjoy a Tonga ride.

Afternoon free at leisure. Overnight at hotel.

**DAY 05      AGRA-JAIPUR (237 Kms)**

After breakfast proceed by car/ coach to Jaipur enroute visiting **Fatehpur Sikri**. Located 40 Km from Agra, the deserted city of Fatehpur Sikri built by Emperor Akbar in 1569, in honour of the great Saint Sheikh Salim Chisti. Scarcity of water was the prime factor for the abandonment of this beautiful city. Visit the remarkably well-preserved, graceful buildings within the 'Ghost City'. Including the **Jama Masjid, tomb of Salim Chisti, Panch Mahal Palace** and other palaces that speak of the grandeur and splendour of the Mughal empire at the height of its power. On arrival in Jaipur check-in at hotel.



Fatehpur Sikri

Evening visit to the **Birla Temple**; the **Laxmi Narayan Mandir** also known as **Birla Mandir** is a modern architectural marvel. The temple has been constructed in white marble and has three domes, each portraying the different approaches to religion. Also enjoy a rickshaw ride along narrow lanes of **Bazaar** (market).

Indulge in a traditional Indian dinner at local restaurant with classical dance performance. Overnight at hotel.

**DAY 06      JAIPUR**

In the morning after breakfast proceed for half day visit of **Amber Fort** with elephant ride. Enroute to Amber Fort, you will have a brief photography stop at **Hawa Mahal** - the Palace of Winds. Amber is a classic, romantic **Rajasthani Fort Palace**. Miniatures painted on the walls depict hunting and war scenes, apart from festivals. Precious stones and mirrors are embedded into the plaster. A major attraction at Amber is the Elephant Ride all the way up to the Fort entrance. With the Jag Mandir is the famed Sheesh Mahal - a room with all the four walls and ceiling completely embedded with glittering mirror pieces, which were specially imported from Belgium.

Afternoon half day city tour begins with a visit to the **Maharaja's City Palace**, part of it converted into a museum. A small portion is still used by the Royal family of Jaipur. One of the major attractions **Armoury Museum** housing an impressive array of weaponry-pistols, blunderbusses, flintlocks, swords, rifles and daggers. Later visit the **Jantar Mantar**, which is the largest stone and marble crafted observatory in the world. Situated near the gate of the city palace, the observatory has 17 large instruments, many of them still in working condition. Overnight at hotel.



**DAY 07 JAIPUR-DELHI**

Morning breakfast at hotel. Afternoon proceed by car/coach to Delhi. On arrival proceed to International airport to connect flight for onwards destination.
