

## 7 DAYS/6 NIGHTS IN THE PHILIPPINES II: NORTHERN ROUNDTRIP TOUR

Day 1 Arrival transfer from NAIA to Hyatt Hotel & Casino. Transfer will be provided by our local representative.  
Your accommodation reserve for two (2) nights in one (1) deluxe double room at Hyatt Hotel and Casino inclusive of breakfast.

Day 2



Early morning breakfast at the hotel. Meet your tour guide at the lobby of the hotel for **Northern Roundtrip Tour**.  
Early morning departure for Banaue, 360 kms from Manila. Travel north on the Expressway and the Cagayan Valley Road, until the town of Bagabag in Nueva Vizcaya, where we start our climb to **Banaue**, 1,300m above sea level. Reach Banaue late afternoon. Check in at the Banaue Hotel. Dinner, after which witness **Ifugao tribal dances** performed by the young and old from the nearby villages.  
Overnight.

Day 3

Breakfast. From the hotel, board a **local jeepney** for a ride to a native village, reachable after a short hike from the main road. After sometime in the village, continue to a vantage point along the main road, to view and admire this 2,000 year old man-made wonder. The **Banaue Rice Terraces**, if placed end to end, would reach half-way around the globe. Proceed to the town's public market to mingle with the local people, and view the vast array of native handicraft. Time permitting, visit another native village returning to the hotel in the afternoon.  
Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Day 4

Breakfast. Drive inland along the winding mountain trail and the **hinterland town of Bontoc**, where the Museum founded by the Belgian sisters is visited. Weather conditions permitting, visit the **Ifugao-burial caves** in Sagada, and intermingle with the natives of the area. Continue the drive through a winding narrow road of unspeakable beauty to **Mt. Data**, atop of which is Mt. Data Lodge. A drink around the hearth precedes dinner. Overnight.



Day 5

Breakfast. A few years ago, in the slopes of **Mt. Timbak** mummies of the Igorot tribe were discovered in the town of Kabay-an. Subject to weather and road conditions, we visit these this morning before continuing the drive, through majestic scenery to Baguio City, the country's summer capital. Check in, dinner and overnight.



Day 6

Breakfast. This morning's tour of this lovely city includes the **Main Street, Session Road, Burnham Park, Mines View Park, The Mansion House and the President's summer residence**. The highlight is the **Public Market**, where the villagers come to sell their goods. Afterwards, drive down to the coast via Naguilian Road and stop for lunch. Return to Manila via the National Highway, passing **Luzon's Central Plain**, and then the North Expressway. Arrive late in the afternoon or early evening. Overnight at Dusit Hotel.

Day 7

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning free at leisure. Check-out at the hotel, transfer from Dusit to International airport. Transfer will be provided by our local representative.
